The Middle-Aged Man's Checklist for Avoiding Heartbreak With Women

- Avoid Uphill Battles, i.e., do not pursue women of wealth or power or exceptional beauty or of
 professional accomplishment far beyond your own, *especially* not those who say that your own
 wealth, power, looks, professional accomplishment are unimportant to them. If it sounds too
 good to be true, it probably is.
- If she is clearly intent on control, terminate the relationship. Control can be manifested in many ways, including:

Repeated claims that she has no interest in control.

Frequent snap psychological judgements, about you and/or about your friends, relatives and other persons. (Whoever judges, favorably or otherwise, is in control.)

Yes but No, No but Yes behavior, e.g. "I want you to speak freely and spontaneously, but there are things you can say that will start major fights, and I can't tell you what these things are in advance."

Long, complex, intense, exhausting conversations that arise because she "doesn't understand" what you are saying. (Whoever is in charge of interpretation, is in charge.) Establishing of conditions: If you will do, or demonstrate, x, then we can do y...

• If the main topic of conversation is usually one or more of the following, terminate the relationship:

The relationship itself;

Past relationships, yours or hers;

Mothers, yours or hers;

Money.

- If one of her past lovers is still very much in the picture, terminate the relationship.
- If she is clearly insecure about your love and your trustworthiness and your potential for long-term commitment despite your past record and repeated assurances and demonstrations to the contrary, terminate the relationship.
- At no time reveal the full extent of your lifelong depression.
- Make no attempts to have sexual relationships with the young. That privilege is reserved for the exceptionally handsome and/or wealthy and/or famous.
- In the case of long-distance relationships, *meet early*! This is the single most important rule for this type of relationship.
